

STUDENT PHYSICAL EXAMINATION AND IMMUNIZATION

REQUIREMENTS FOR MASSAC UNIT #1

FOR STUDENT TO ENTER:

Early Childhood Education or Pre-Kindergarten Program :

- * Must have a physical exam completed within one year prior to the date of entry into school
- * Completed evaluation for lead poisoning risk
- * Up-to-date immunizations

Kindergarten:

- Must have a physical exam completed within one year prior to the date of entry into school
- Completed evaluation for lead poisoning risk
- Up-to-date immunizations
- Completed Eye Exam within one year prior to the first day of kindergarten
- Dental Exam before May 15th

2nd GRADE:

- Dental Exam before May 15th

6th GRADE:

- Must have a physical exam completed within one year prior to the date of entry
- Up-to-date Immunizations
- Dental Exam before May 15th

9th Grade:

- Must have a physical exam completed within one year prior to the date of entry
- Up-to-date immunizations

First-Time Illinois Students (any grade level):

- Must have a physical exam completed within **ONE** year prior to the date of entry into an Illinois school
- Up-to-date immunizations which comply with the State of Illinois requirements
- Eye Exam completed within one year of entering an Illinois school

NOTE: Transfer students have **30 days** from the date of entry to comply with examination and immunization requirements!

Sports Physicals:

Any 7th-12th Grade student who is going to play sports will need a **SPORTS PHYSICAL** before they will be allowed to participate (**IHSA/IESA** form)

NOTE: Students who do not meet these requirements by October 15th of each school year **WILL NOT** be allowed to come to school after October 15th until in full compliance per ILLINOIS SCHOOL LAW.

Please do NOT use an IHSA/IESA Sports form for the **REQUIRED** Grade level PHYSICAL EXAMS (**ECE, Pre-K, Kindergarten, 6th, or 9th grade**).
